



### Fleggburgh Speed Watch

A brief update on the recent activities of the Fleggburgh Speed Watch team of volunteers.

Your Speed Watch volunteers have been undertaking regular speed monitoring sessions within areas of St Margaret's, Billockby and Clippesby. The frequency of activities is dependent upon criteria such as the availability of volunteers and weather conditions. Detailed below are additional data on the sessions held since May 2023.

May, 1 session took place and 6 vehicles reported to the Norfolk Police

June, 2 sessions took place and 8 vehicles reported to the Norfolk Police

July, 4 sessions took place and over 50 vehicles were reported to the Norfolk Police

All owners of these vehicles would have been recorded as travelling more than the speed limit of either 30 or 40 mph will receive a formal letter and notification that any subsequent reporting will lead to further action.

In addition, speed monitoring 24x7 is captured by the installation of SAM2 (speed awareness modules) located in various positions around St Margaret's, Billockby and Clippesby. These devices flash up the actual speed the vehicle is doing and displays a message advising to Slow Down if in excess of the speed limit. The Speed Watch team then produce detailed reports that allow the team to investigate locations where excess speeds occur and assist in determining where locations would benefit from identifying those vehicles. These SAM2's are put up in a location and remain there for approximately 4 weeks and then relocated to a new location.

The Speed Watch team publish the SAM2 reports to the Parish Council, who in turn upload onto there website so everybody can see the results.

Reports covering: Town Road, Main Road, Tower Road, Mill Lane and Rollesby Road are available to view.

Finally, a representative of the Norfolk Police Safety Camera Team attended Fleggburgh on Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> July and undertook speed recording outside the Village Hall.
